Natural Church Development

Natural Church Development is both a tool and a community. The process is an orientation towards church growth and strategic planning that is grounded in a parish's measurement of health in eight areas. The research supporting this process is extensive, based initially on 1,000 churches in 32 countries and confirmed through work in 55,000 churches in 70 countries over the past 15 years.

The **NCD Survey** measures parish health in these areas: leadership, ministry, spirituality, structures, worship service, small groups, evangelism, and relationships based on the research indicating that healthy churches manifest

- Empowering leadership
- Passionate spirituality
- Effective structures
- Inspiring worship services
- Holistic small groups
- Need-oriented evangelism
- Loving relationships

Once a parish identifies its strengths and challenges, the NCD organization offers resources that support strategic planning to enable the parish to grow and deepen in these areas.
