

Report of the Bishop's Decennial Inspection Committee

The BDIC has the task of encouraging the parishes to schedule their decennial inspections when they come due. We also review the inspection documents when they are submitted to ensure that they meet the requirements of the terms of reference.

The committee assists parishes (when requested) in developing action plans for completion of critical items on the inspection report. We also conduct structural reviews of vacant diocesan buildings and provide advice on other unique building issues.

6 decennial inspections have been completed so far this year (4 of those were outstanding from previous years). At present, 5 inspections are overdue, and 3 are on the schedule to be completed this year. 11 inspections are coming due in 2017.

It is the hope of the committee to become more of a resource to the parishes in working through the inspection process and in dealing with identified repair items.
