Purpose of the Position

- prepare choir and singers to sing liturgical settings
- lead the choir and congregational singers in a manner that facilitates their development of vocal skills

- arrange for guest musicians/singers and special music for Christmas Eve, Easter, Lessons and Carols, and other special services
- in consultation with the Rector and Music Minister, arrange for substitute replacements when deemed necessary
- other duties as assigned by the Rector

- this position includes work on Sundays, some Saturdays, and on weeknights as required
- two weeks of paid vacation per year at a time agreed upon with the Rectors
- the position will begin with a three month probationary period
- renewable annual contract based on need and successful annual staff evaluation
