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MINUTES OF THE 138th SYNOD OF THE DIOCESE OF NIAGARA HELD NOVEMBER 17, 2012 IN BURLINGTON

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 2012

The Synod Eucharist was held at St. Christopher's. The Bishop delivered his Charge to Synod.

2013 GENERAL SYNOD NOMINATIONS

Canon Robert Welch outlined the voting process for General Synod. The 8 clergy and 10 laity nominees were asked to stand. General Synod Balloting began and the Chancellor informed delegates that the ballot boxes for General Synod elections would be closed at 2:15 p.m.

CANONICAL CHANGES

Canon 4.6 (1)-(3) On Erection or Alteration of Church Buildings

MOTION: The Reverend Canon Marni Nancekivell/Canon Robert Welch THAT Canon 4.6 be amended to read, "No church building shall be erected or altered, and no new work commenced on any real estate belonging to or held by the parish church or diocese without the written permission of the Diocesan Bishop. Municipal building permits should not be applied for until this permission is received.

Specific regulations related to procedures for approval of parish building projects and financing shall be set by the Bishop and Synod Council in consultation with those named in the regulations. It shall be the duty of the Incumbent and Church Wardens to seek out, review and comply with current regulations governing the erection or alteration of church buildings, as well as complying with conditions contained within the Bishop's approval.

Any memorial gifts or donations of a permanent nature that affect the fixtures or fittings, fabric or structure of the church are considered to be alterations and will be subject to this Canon. CARRIED.

GOVERANCE WORKING GROUP REPORT

Opening remarks by Canon Rob Fead. A video presentation was given, the reshaping of new ways to learn and work together. The model is broad and is still a work in progress. Propose Synod Council as a Niagara Synod Forum to be held between regular Synod Sessions. Three tables - Vision & Mission (share stories - mission and guiding those who live it out); Governance (financial, property, policy and Canons); Episcopal (leadership and ministry - Human Resources and Ministry Covenants, communication, planning and identity). Where are we going and how are we doing? A document outlining the concept was distributed to Synod delegates along with a form asking for feedback on the concept. Canon Rob Fead thanked Canon Margaret Murray on her technical presentation, Canon Marni Nancekivell and Mrs. Karen Nowicki for their assistance.

ANNOUNCEMENTS and BREAK

Canon Mark Tiller made announcements.

Bishop Bird announced the appointments of four new Canons -David Anderson, Jean Archbell, Kevin Bothwell and Rob Hurkmans.

LIVING WAGE

WHEREAS we are a people of faith striving to live into God's vision of justice, where all have enough; AND

WHEREAS a living wage enables a person "to have a decent quality of life ... to enjoy recreation, culture, and entertainment, and participate fully in social life"; AND WHEREAS the City of Hamilton's living wage rate has been calculated to be \$14.95/hr for 2011-2012; AND

WHEREAS the Social Planning Network of Ontario has called for minimum wage levels in 2014 to be set at \$12.50/hr and indexed thereafter so that a full-time, fullyear worker earns an annual income 10% above the poverty line.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1) This Synod affirms the Bishop's request that all parishes engage in discussion about fair compensation through living wages for lay employees before setting their 2013 budgets;

2) This Synod requests that all Parish Corporations ensure their employees are paid a minimum of \$12.50/hr by 2014. CARRIED.

PWRDF/PARTNERS IN MISSION

Canon Stuart Pike, Rector of St. Luke's, Burlington, introduced Jose Zarate, Indigenous Communities and Latin America/Caribbean Program Coordinator from the Primate's World Relief and Development Fund, to speak about Cuba and the destruction Hurricane Sandy left behind. The Diocese of Niagara pledged \$7,000 to aid our brothers and sisters in Cuba with basic needs of food, clothing and rebuilding of homes. Any amount raised over and above the \$7,000 will be used to rebuild minor damage caused to churches and for education.

CATHEDRAL PLACE PROPERTY

WHEREAS "Cathedral Place" came into being over two decades ago as an innovative and coordinated asset to the ongoing benefit of Anglicans in The Diocese of Niagara; AND

WHEREAS Cathedral Place is a unique asset, not a liability, to The Anglican Diocese of Niagara; AND

WHEREAS neither the original Cathedral Place agreement, nor its subsequent revisions, were ever been signed either by the Cathedral Congregation nor the Synod of the Diocese of Niagara, yet are in use; AND

WHEREAS the exterior and interior Historical Designation of Cathedral Place, amongst other considerations, indicates that this asset will not be disposed of but will remain in our care for many years to come; AND

WHEREAS the benefits of this agreement have not been properly celebrated in the context of the wider Diocese; AND

WHEREAS the challenges of this agreement indicate a need for transparent and informed evaluation as they impact future operations, budgets and, more importantly, are at the heart of the Diocesan Vision and Mission.

MOTION: The Reverend Canon David Pickett/Mr. Ian Pratt BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1) Synod direct Synod Council to initiate a study of benefits pertaining to, costs involved in, and concerns with the operation of Cathedral Place, such study to involve the Cathedral Place Property Management Committee, representatives of the Financial Advisory Committee, The Corporation of Christ's Church Cathedral, other Synod Council members 'at large', and any others whose gifts or involvement the Council deems to be helpful to the process; AND
- 2) Synod further directs that a report along with recommendations for the future benefit of Cathedral Place and its operations (particularly any recommendations affecting the draft 'Cathedral Place Agreement' and its future ratification) be delivered to Synod in 2013.

GRACE AND LUNCH

Canon Terry DeForest said Grace and lunch commenced.

VISION THEME VIDEO

Canon Rob Hurkmans, Team Leader for Continuous Culture of Innovation, produced and presented an entertaining video to delegates on the Diocesan Vision and parishes' responses. Delegates were asked to break off in small groups and answer the following question, In the coming year what will it look like to be passionately following Christ, as individuals, as a parish and as a community. The results of reflection were then posted on the windows of the church.

2013 BUDGET PRESENTATION

Mr. Andrew Clinkard, Chair of the Finance Budget Sub-Committee of the Financial Advisory Committee, presented a PowerPoint presentation with an overview of the Proposed 2013-2014 Budget. Five regional meetings were held prior to Synod with 160 people attending. Feedback was received from those regional meetings to assist with the final draft budget presented at Synod. He thanked Senior Staff and the Bishop for their vision and support.

HANDS ACROSS NIAGARA

The Reverend Derek Anderson, St. Matthews on-the-Plains, Burlington, made a presentation to members on the Hands Across Niagara program. Hands Across Niagara supports our ability to engage God's mission throughout our diocese and beyond as we live out our baptism by committing to justice and servant ministries. He talked about building relationships with our neighbors and empowering members of our communities. He touched on the various programs undertaken in some parishes across Niagara which were made possible through grants provided by Hands Across Niagara. Key dates for 2013 are with maximum grants increasing to \$2,500 are: January 15 - Call for Grant Applications; March 1 - Grant Applications Due; April 14 - Campaign Sunday; May 14 - Funding Decisions Communicated.

PRESENTATION

Presentation to Karen Nowicki for recognition of her hard work in the organization of Synod.

2013 BUDGET DISCUSSION - QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- St. Luke's, Palermo support there are a lot of numbers that pertain to Palermo. The joint proposal with Versa Care is no longer financially viable, St. Luke's will continue with the project without partnership and the Diocese is assisting financially to complete the Parish Centre.
- If some churches don't have the money to pay the DM&M then how can the Diocese spend when they won't be getting all they budget for? The Diocese carries long term debt but have had significant pay downs and hope that continues in 2013.
- There has been a 60% reduction in staff at the Synod Office since Bishop Bird was elected. There is a need for a better understanding of the Diocesan vision and the Bishop challenged all Councils to get a better understanding of what we are being called to, engage in conversation in a meaningful and positive way.
- How will we be able to meet budget when we are still trying to juggle scarcity and hope for more abundance? Have we moved back to a model of scarcity and not abundance?
- We need to balance scarcity with abundance.
- If incomes increase so will the DM&M and how can we manage this with an aging congregation and declining attendance?
- A task force will look at all properties/assets in the diocese.
- Parishes should have more money to do social justice in their own communities.
- Parishes are delving into line of credits and investments, it's a cascading affect that maybe we can't afford to do, may be called to a different kind of church

RECTORY FUNDS

Jody Beck explained the way Rectory Funds work according to the legislation from the Province of Ontario, Trust Laws, Diocesan Canons, Rectory Funds Policy and Administrative Guidelines. The sale of a Rectory original amount must always be maintained with the interest drawn upon. In some cases a loan may be granted against the principal but it must be paid back. Some churches have not adhered to this policy. November 30, 2012 a letter will be sent to all parishes advising them of their current balances, current growth and position. If in a negative position borrowing from the fund cannot continue and the original principal must be attained. There are 64 Rectory funds held by the Anglican Church Ministries Founding totalling over \$7 million dollars.

2008 rules suggest Parishes grow and maintain the fund at a balance equivalent to cost of a 3 bedroom home in their community. This is no longer a realistic measurement, unable to accurately measure and the original sale proceeds may not have represented a 3 bedroom house.

The new proposal will:

- ➤ Anticipate fluctuating market conditions
- Take into account the current status of fund balances
- ➤ Use a measureable method for loan approvals
- ➤ Allow for an "Appeal" process for new requests
- ➤ Loan approval process (allow time)
- New loans cannot be taken if a loan is outstanding
- Loans are restricted to use as per Trust rules
- Loans are not allowed if fund has Restricted Fund has negative balance
- Loans require repayments in reasonable time period, with Interest paid to fund
- > Draws will be limited to those whose Restricted Funds are positive current and future
- Dec 2012 Confirmation letter to fund holders
 - ➤ Balance as at Nov 30 Net and components
 - ➤ Notice if restricted funds are negative
 - Notice if current draws are reducing capital
- Dec 2012 Parishes to review Confirmation
 - > Respond to confirmation identify any issues
 - Prepare for 2013 changes if drawings to be halted
- 2013 Synod Council to review proposed policy
 - Review / amend proposed policy
- Determine date of enactment of proposed policy
