Organist / Choir Director

St. Paul's Anglican Church, Fort Erie, is seeking a part time Organist and Choir Director.

We have a small choir that is open to new challenges. The position requires excellent leadership skill as well as the ability to play hymns, anthems, choral responses in liturgy, preludes, and postludes.

For this ministry, a familiarity with church music in a liturgical setting is desirable. The successful applicant will be expected to play at the 11:00 a.m. Sunday service with the choir. This position requires leading weekly scheduled rehearsals with the choir to prepare the hymns and anthems. She or he will also meet regularly with the Rector to plan music for services, and will give all music selections to the Parish Administrator for the weekly bulletin in a timely fashion.

The Organist/Choir Director will have right of first refusal for any weddings or funerals in the parish. Salary is commensurate with education and experience. This position is considered 6 hours per week.
